ADELAIDE ITALIAN FESTIVAL

The Adelaide Italian Festival is an opportunity for all South Australians to celebrate and immerse themselves in Italian culture. The open-access event celebrates and promotes all things Italian including food and wine, art, culture, music and theatre, fashion and design, cars, cycling and sport, and technology and space exploration.

The first Italian Festival in Adelaide was held in 1976 in Rundle Mall – a parade made up of migrant families travelling from Victoria Square to Elder Park before ending with celebrations in Rundle Mall. Originally called The Italian Festival, and later known as "Carnevale", the Adelaide Italian Festival returned to its original name to honour those who have come before them.

The festival has been a means of inspiring young people to embrace their Italian heritage and for the wider community to experience Italian culture. The festival features numerous family-friendly events in various locations around Adelaide, such as cooking classes, workshops, masterclasses, exhibitions and more.
